Georgi Chaltikyan, MD, PhD is professor of Digital Health and Healthcare Management, and director of the study program Master of Medical Informatics (MMI) at Deggendorf University of Applied Science (Deggendorf Institute of Technology, DIT) in Bavaria, Germany, and founding president of Armenian Association of Telemedicine (AATM).
